

Translation of Fillmore Symbols by Jose Davila

To dig out of earth precious garlanded everlasting mineral records which are housed in natural stone chamber.

Begin a square land measurement descending from that which is in front of petroglyphs or rock at the horizon merger orienting it with the for cardinal points, to gain entrance measure the two sides towards the constellation of the great bear, the square land measurement has crossing diagonals with intersecting points by placing the two sides closing the square land measurement, measure 100 cubits per side, retreating down the center summit to remove from place of concealment, metal tablets.

According to Jose Davila translation a cubit is the value of 20.5 inches, 170^{+17} to a 100 cubits.
